# Charter

To Whom It May Concern, Greetings:

Whereas, an application has been received from

for a LOCAL UNION CHARTER of the INTERNATIONAL HOD CARRIERS', BUILDING AND COMMON LABORERS' UNION OF AMERICA hereinafter referred to as the International Union to be located at

SARNIA, ONTARIO, CANADA

Now therefore, acting under and in pursuance of the authority vested in us by the Constitution and laws of the International Union, we issue this charter to the applicants and to their legally elected successors to institute and constitute a Local Union to be known as

## Construction and General Laborers'

Local Union No. 1089

to be located at Sarnia, Ontario, Canada to bear the date of May 1, 1951

with the following territorial jurisdiction: Sarnia, Ontario, Canada

and with the following craft jurisdiction: Construction and General Laborers'

The International Union retains and reserves the right to revise, restrict or enlarge the territorial and craft jurisdiction hereinbefore set forth; and by virtue of this charter the Local Union is hereby authorized and empowered to initiate into the Local Union any persons duly proposed and approved by the Local Union and who according to the Constitution of the International are eligible to membership and to do and perform such other acts as are prescribed in the Constitution, laws and rules of the International Union. Provided always that the said Local Union conforms to the Constitution, laws and rules of the International Union and that said Local Union does not remove from its granted territorial jurisdiction without the consent of the International Union.

The International Union retains and reserves the right to suspend or revoke this charter in accordance with the Constitution, Laws and Rules of the International Union, and in the event that the said Local Union is dissolved or its charter revoked or forfeited, then all its property, books, and papers shall become the property of the International Union.

In Witness Whereof we have subscribed our names and affixed the seal of the INTERNATIONAL HOD CARRIERS', BUILDING AND COMMON LABORERS' UNION OF AMERICA on this 9th day of May 1951.





# The Founding of **LiUNA!**

**APRIL 13, 1903**

The story of LiUNA begins on April 13, 1903, when delegates from 23 independent local unions met in Washington, D.C., and formed the International Hod Carriers and Building Common Labourers Union of America.

Among the most influential figures in LiUNA's early years was Domenico D'Alessandro, an Italian immigrant from Boston Local Union 209. He played a pivotal role in organizing new locals, improving conditions for immigrant workers, and laying the foundation for LiUNA's emergence as a powerful advocate for labourers across North America.



Many of the union's early members were immigrants from Italy, Belgium, and other European countries, who came seeking opportunities but often encountered harsh working conditions, low wages, and little protection.

United by a common purpose, they fought not only for fair pay and safer workplaces, but also for dignity, respect, and solidarity in an industry that often treated them as expendable.

In 1907, Domenico D'Alessandro became a general organizer for the union, and within a year, he was elected General President, a position he held from 1908 until his death in 1926. He understood that the union's strength depended on inclusion and unity, welcoming workers regardless of nationality, ethnicity, or race. Under his leadership, what had been a loose coalition of local labourers grew dramatically into a powerful, continent-wide organization.



By 1920, LiUNA had grown to 548 Local Unions with over 96,000 members, including both immigrant and native-born labourers. Together, these early members built roads, bridges, tunnels, and buildings, literally shaping North American infrastructure while also establishing modern labour standards and challenging both economic exploitation and racial segregation in the workforce.



LiUNA Local 1089 was chartered as a union on May 1, 1951, in Sarnia, strengthening the union's presence in Ontario and contributing to its growing foundation of skilled, dedicated labourers. Today, LiUNA represents over half a million workers in Canada and the United States from construction and utilities to public service and environmental work. The union celebrates its diversity, welcoming immigrants, women, and workers from all walks of life.

## Bluewater Bridge & Customs Booths

LiUNA Local 1089 has been proud to play a vital role in building and maintaining the Second Bluewater Bridge and its customs booths in Sarnia, Ontario, an iconic local landmark and one of Canada's busiest international crossings.





Local 1089 members continuously support the construction, upkeep, and long-term reliability of these facilities, ensuring safe travel and secure border operations. With expert craftsmanship and rigorous safety standards, LiUNA Local 1089 continues to ensure this landmark remains safe, dependable, and built to last.



# St. Clair Tunnel Replacement

The original St. Clair Tunnel, opened in 1891, connected Sarnia, Ontario, with Port Huron, Michigan, beneath the St. Clair River. In 1993, construction commenced on a new tunnel, utilizing the Excalibore tunnel-boring machine launched from the Canadian side.

Alongside this advanced machinery, teams of skilled labourers played a crucial role, supporting excavation, operating equipment, reinforcing tunnel walls, and ensuring safety throughout the process. Thanks to the combined effort of cutting-edge technology and dedicated workers, the St. Clair Tunnel replacement opened in 1994.

## Western Oils Down Slightly

TORONTO (CP) — Western  
 oil issues edged fractionally  
 lower while prices in all other  
 major sectors of the Toronto  
 stock market moved higher in  
 moderate mid-morning trading  
 today.

The industrial index was up  
 21 to 31.44, golds 1.84 to 144.70  
 and base metals 14 to 70.24.  
 Western oil was off 81 to  
 137.74.

Volume by 11 a.m. was 154,225  
 shares, compared with 105,000  
 at the same time Monday.

Strength of the industrial in-  
 dex's 17 sub-groups was mar-  
 cksizing. Other advancing  
 sectors were beverages, com-

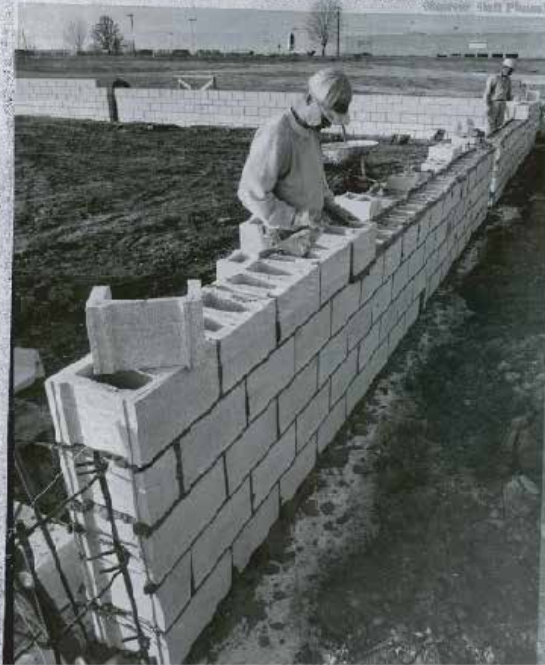

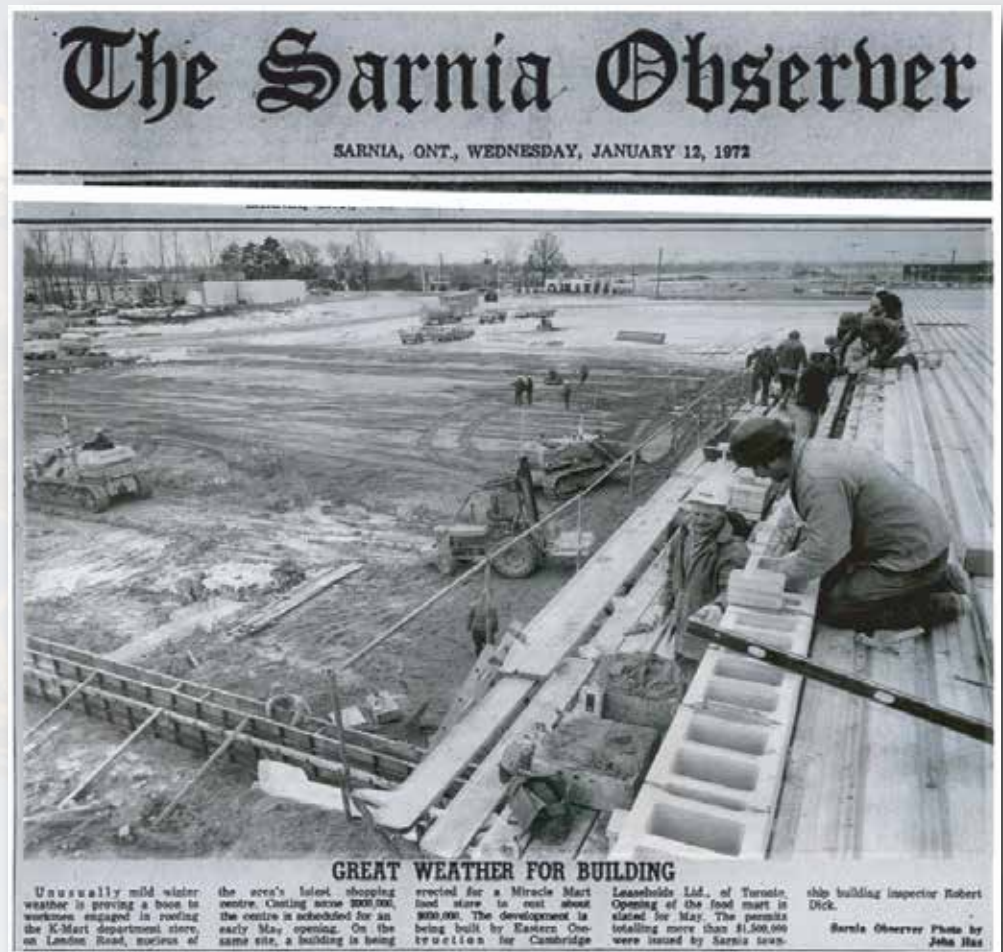

Brick facing has been completed and the background for the sign is being raised on the Miracle Mart ABOVE. Sand blasting is in progress on the outside of the K-Mart department store, while inside fixtures are being put in place by Alka Selzer Limited, of Toronto. BELOW, in less than eight hours checkout counters had been installed, counters for merchandise were being assembled in pre-fab units and lighting fixtures were laid out on the floor, preparatory to being raised in place. Stocking of the department store is scheduled to begin in two weeks. Meanwhile a representative of Eastern Construction Limited, general contractor, said the green light has been given by developer Cambridge Leaseholds of Toronto for a start on a wing which will house a bank, drug store and restaurant.

We equip our members with top-tier skills by offering trade and sector-specific training, which keeps our members current in meeting industry standards and health and safety regulations.

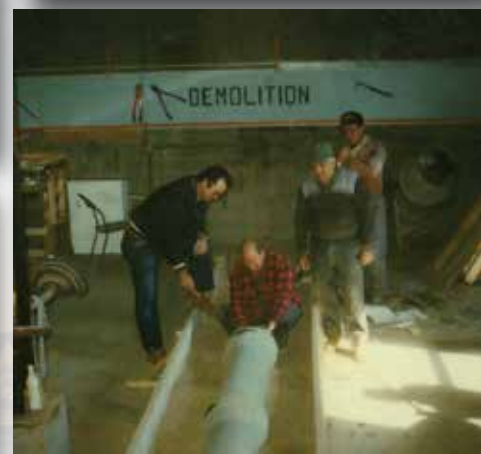
